Qualifications

The successful candidates will demonstrate a high degree of autonomy and professionalism. They must be currently registered as Trinity College students in good standing. A working knowledge of Trinity College, including: the residences, academic services and social opportunities is important. Should be comfortable speaking to groups. Previous presentation and/or tour guide experience is an asset.

SUMMER TERM (2025)

CONTRACT PERIOD: May 6th, 2025 - August 23rd, 2025

REMUNERATION: Trinity College will run 2-3 tours a week throughout the summer session, and individual tour guides can expect to be scheduled for a minimum of one tour per week. Tour Guides will be compensated at a rate of \$35 per tour. The tours are approximately an hour long.

- Ensure that the information shared on the tours is up-to-date and accurate

- Interact and work with prospective students and their families, as well as general public guests to the college
- Work on a rotating schedule, and should expect to lead approximately 12+ tours per semester, including special events

- Tour Guides are <u>not required to live in residence</u>.
- Tour Guides are <u>not required to be registered in courses</u>
- Cannot have graduated from their undergraduate degree yet

FALL/WINTER TERM (2025-2026)

CONTRACT PERIOD: September 2, 2025 – April 10, 2026

REMUNERATION: Trinity will run up to 3-4 tours (online and in-person) a week throughout the fall and winter terms. Individual tour guides can expect to be scheduled for a minimum of one tour per week. Tour Guides will be compensated at a rate of \$30 per tour.
